Re: LADCO VOC Regulations

There has been quite a bit of confusion lately regarding regional VOC rules in the Midwest U.S., and how they apply to specific W. R. MEADOWS' products. This letter will attempt to clarify some of these issues.

LADCO (The Lake Michigan Air Directors Consortium) was established in 1990 as a non-profit organization to assist the member states with regional air quality issues. Originally, there were four (4) states involved, Illinois, Indiana, Michigan and Wisconsin, with Ohio joining as the fifth (5th) member, in March of 2004. While each of these five (5) states participates and contributes to LADCO, each state continues to issue and govern their own individual, "state-specific" VOC rules and regulations.

In support of our on-going efforts to provide our customers with the most accurate and current information, the attached document lists the product categories, as well as the W. R. MEADOWS' products governed by these VOC regulations.
